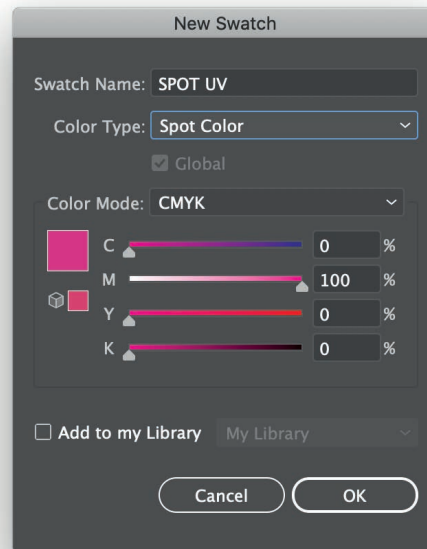
SETUP GUIDE

SPOT UV

Artwork should be supplied as a high-resolution PDF, with all Spot UV elements on extra page(s) and set as a Spot colour named 'Spot UV'

1 Open your artwork (Ensure all artwork includes at least 5mm bleed).

2 Create a new swatch. **Change colour type to 'Spot Colour'** and set the Magenta value to 100%. Ensure both fill and opacity settings are also set to 100%



3 Create a new artboard for your Spot UV Artwork.

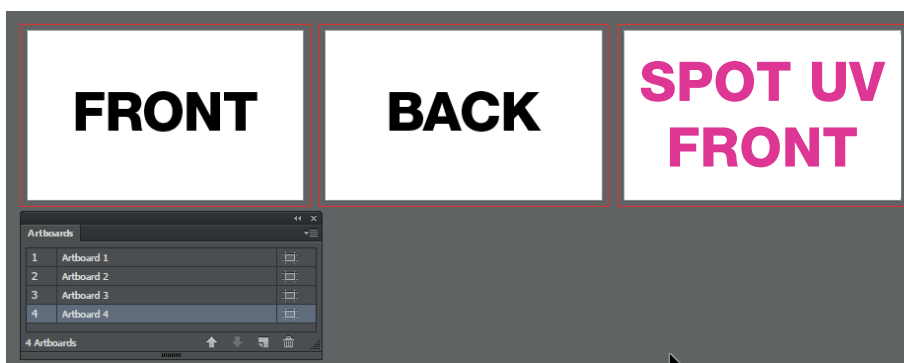
4 Select the elements you wish to enhance with Spot UV on your original artboard and duplicate them to the new Spot UV artboard. **Change the colour of the Spot UV elements to the 'Spot UV' spot colour created in Step 2. Make sure the element on your new artboards are identical in all respects to size, orientation, crop, position of images and text to your original artwork.**

Artboard 1 - Front Artwork

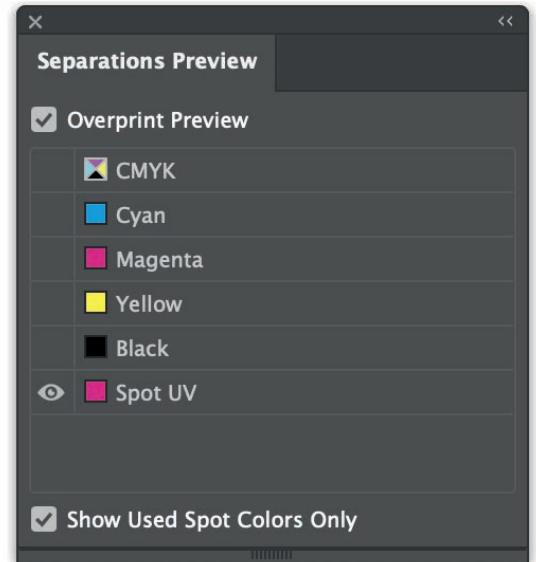
Artboard 2 - Back Artwork

- 6 Go into the Separation Preview palette (Window > Separation Preview). Tick Overprint Preview and view only the Spot UV colour to ensure your spot colour has been applied.



- 7 To submit artwork, all files must be saved as a press ready PDF. **Don't forget to include trims and bleed!**



It is **IMPORTANT** to make sure that the 'Spot UV' elements identical in all respects to size, orientation, crop, position of images and text to your original CMYK artwork.



Things to Avoid

For the best print result, avoid applying Spot UV to thin lines, small text or finely detailed artwork.
